1856–1920

The Rev. W.W. Watts was Honorary Curator of Cryptogams at the National Herbarium of New South Wales (1909-1916); many thousands of his collections of mosses, hepatics and ferns are housed in the Herbarium. He contributed greatly to our knowledge of these groups during his lifetime, through publications and by exchange of specimens with overseas herbaria. Botany was his hobby; his occupation was minister in the Presbyterian Church of New South Wales. The *W.W. Watts Room* houses the cryptogamic collections of the National Herbarium of New South Wales.
